A bachelor's degree in Exercise Science prepares students for careers in sport and fitness related settings outside the public schools. It does NOT prepare students to qualify for teacher certification.

- Admission is competitive. Completion of minimum requirements does not guarantee admission.
- Cumulative GPA of 2.75 required (including transfer hrs); 2.75 GPA also required for admission requirements.
- Minimum of 30 credit hrs required for admission. All courses must be completed for graduation (at least 120 hrs).
- Application deadline is February 1. Check www.soe.ku.edu for more information.
