- Minimum cumulative and core GPAs of 2.75 (including all transfer hours) and a minimum of 30 hours required for admission to School of Education. Admission into Health and Physical Education program is selective; minimum cumulative and core GPAs do not guarantee admission.
- Minimum total hours required for graduation is 120.

- A maximum of 64 hours of community college course work can be applied toward a KU degree
- Courses with a grade of D or below do not transfer
